BE IT ENACTED by the Yobe State House of Assembly;-

Citation and Commencement

1. This law may be cited as the Yobe State Bureau for Public Procurement as the Regulatory Authority Responsible for the Monitoring and Oversight of Public Procurement (Amendment No.2) Law 2019 and shall come into force on the <sup>31<sup>st</sup></sup>.....day of <sup>DEC.</sup>..... 2019

Amendment to section "4"

2. Section 4(2) of the Yobe State Bureau for Public Procurement Law 2016 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law) is hereby amended by the addition of new paragraph (m) and re-arrangement of paragraphs to read as follows:-

- “(j) the representative of Professional Accounting Body.
- (k) Six other members of proven integrity to be appointed by the Governor, two from each of the senatorial district of the state;
- (l) The Director General of the Bureau who shall be the Secretary to the Council.”

*Amendment to Section “64”*


3. Section 64 of the Yobe State Bureau for Public Procurement law 2016 (herein after referred to as the “Principal law”) is hereby amended by the addition of new subsections (5 & 6) to read as follows: -

(5) “Notwithstanding the provisions of section 40, 41, 42, 43 and 44 above, the Bureau shall with the approval of the Council design and set up a secured electronic portal which shall be the primary source of information for all public procurement matters and opportunities within the purview of this law and its regulations issued under this law.

(6) “ Subject to the provisions of this law and its regulations, it shall be lawful for any procuring entity to consider any or all of its tenders by electronic auction and or simulation on its electronic portal, provided that the use of the electronic system shall be transparent, efficient and economical.”
